The races!! November 18th and 19th

The first two races will be scored as the make-up races for the Feb.2006 Naples~Marco Island Hospice Regatta and determine the team that will represent Hospice in the National Hospice Alliance Regatta in Annapolis in May of 2007. All the boats that paid their entry for the Feb. Hospice Regatta are still entered with no additional fee for Hospice; the entry fee for the MIYC Regatta is according to the schedule shown later in these documents. All of the races will count as races for the 2006 MIYC Fall Regatta, in other words, the first two races will count in both events.

The races will start at 11:00 AM. The shore activities will be at the times shown below. On Saturday, weather permitting, we plan to run three races for Spinnaker boats, Sportboats and Multihulls and two longer races for PHRF Non-Spin and True Cruising. All racing should be finished by about 4:30 PM. Sunday there will be one race starting at 11:00 AM and finishing by 3:00 PM. The courses will be designed to the liking of each class. The Hospice classes remain the same as their NOR definitions. The scorer will place each boat in its appropriate class as defined for each Regatta. The MIYC Sailing Instructions will govern the race rules of both Regattas.

The Big Party, Sunday, November 19th 5:00 PM

Two people get free admittance for each MIYC Regatta entry. The cost for additional attendees, including tax and tip, is \$20.00 or \$25.00 per person for the crews of boats only participating in the Hospice portion of the Regatta. If not paid for with your entry fee, please give your money to the Cash Bar ticket seller. The party includes live music for three hours by J. Robert, a fabulous Chef Mark Z Buffet. Keg beer is also part of the package. The bar will be open for your pleasure. Purchase tickets to exchange at the bar for drinks. Embroidered Polo Shirts and T-shirts commemorating the event will be on sale at \$35 and \$15 respectively, including tax. There will be a 50/50 Drawing; a single winner gets half and the MICKYS Program gets the rest. And, of course, the winners of the sailing race classes will be announced and awarded their prizes, including Spinnaker Overall for Spin A & B and Sportboats, Non-Spinnaker including PHRF Non- Spinnaker and True Cruising, and Multihull including Corsair 24 and other Multihulls. The music and beer starts at 5PM with Attitude adjustment 5-6PM, Dinner 6-7PM, Awards and Boasting 7PM - ?? The Cash Bar will be open early, if you arrive before 5PM.

The Hospice trophies and the announcement of the representative for the National Hospice Alliance Regatta 2007 will also be announced.

Notice of Race – Nov. 18th & 19th, 2006

1. RULES:

1.1 - The Regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) (2006-1908).

1.2 - The organizing authority (OA) is the Marco Island Yacht Club (MIYC), Marco Island, Florida.

1.3 - This is a Category "A" event.

1.4 - The following rules have been amended by the Sailing Instructions: 35, 69, A4.1.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

2.1 - Open to all multihulls and self righting single hulled enclosed cabin sail boats that conform to their class rules and hold a valid West Florida PHRF rating, are assigned a rating by the OA or are a recognized one-design racing in a one design class.

2.2 - Boat owners that are not members of WFPHRF will have a WFPHRF equivalent rating assigned to them for this regatta only. This assigned rating cannot be appealed.

3. ENTRIES and FEES:

3.1 - The entry fee before 5:00 PM on Nov. 8th is \$77.00 (\$70 with proof of USSA Membership). After Nov. 8th the fee is \$87 or \$80 (with USSA). **You can pay by credit card. Fax the Entry Form, PHRF and USSA to 394-1198.** This fee includes complimentary beer at the Skipper's meeting and first day's post race meeting and the Award's ceremony. It also includes the Buffet and entertainment for **two** people at Sunday's Awards ceremony. Additional persons are welcome and encouraged to attend the Awards ceremony for a fee of **\$20.00** which **must be paid to the** Cash Bar ticket sellers or prepaid with the entry form. Hospice only participants are \$25 per person for the Awards banquet.

3.2 - Entries shall be made on the Official Entry Form, accompanied by a copy of a WFPHRF Rating certificate, or it's rating equivalent, and USSA membership for the discount and check for the entry fee and additional dinners made payable to MIYC MICKYS Program.

3.3 - Entry Deadline is 18:00 hrs. Tuesday, Nov. 14th, 2006.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

5.1 - Sailing Instructions (SI's) will be provided to all entrants at the skipper's meeting.

6. CLASSES:

6.1 - The following classes may be formed: Spinnaker, PHRF Non-Spinnaker, True Cruising, SportBoat and Multihull (Corsair 24 MK II). Race courses will be designed with the desires of the class entries considered, but the final selection will be determined by the PRO, Race Committee Leader. The number of starts will be determined by the race courses and the number of entries in each class. In general, there will be at least seven boats in each start, but there will be awards for each class. A minimum of three entries are required to form a class. One Design classes will receive awards if there are five entries in the class.

Awards per class shall be: 3 Entries = 1st Place; 4-5 Entries = 1st & 2nd; 6+ Entries = 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

7. REGISTRATION and SKIPPERS MEETING:

7.1 - At least one representative from each entered boat must register at Friday's Skippers meeting and pick up a class flag and a copy of the Sailing Instructions. Beer will be compliments of MIYC. (A cash bar and cash food will also be available.) **You can arrive early or stay after for dining.**

8. RACING:

8.1 - The venue for all races shall be in the Gulf of Mexico North of Capri Pass R '2'. The warning signal for the first race on Saturday shall be made at approximately 1055 hrs. The race committee will attempt to run **two long** races on this day for the PHRF Non Spinnaker and True Cruising classes and **three races** for all other classes. The warning signal for subsequent races shall be made as soon as possible after the last boat finished the previous race or approximately one hour after the first boat finishes the class. The warning signal for Sunday's race shall be made at approximately 1055 hrs. No Warning Signal shall be made after 1400hrs. on Sunday.

9. COURSES:

9.1 - The course to be sailed, the bearing and approximate distance to the first mark will be posted on the course board displayed on the Race Committee Signal Boat. Probable course layouts will be depicted in Addendums to the Sailing Instructions. Each class may be presented with a course that differs from the other classes.

10. SCORING:

10.1 – For this regatta, a SW Florida 2007-8 BOTY event, corrected times shall be calculated based on the boat's WFPHRF rating or assigned rating(see 2.2), the distance of the course sailed, and the actual elapsed time in which the course was sailed (time on distance).

10.2 – For SW Florida BOTY the results will be rescored using the High-Point Percentage Scoring System. DNF and DNS get five points for reporting to the RC Signal Boat at the Start Line. DNC and DSQ get zero points. One race can constitute a regatta and no score will be excluded.

10.3 – The WFPHRF RLC Rating will be used for all races in which less than approximately 75% of the total distance of the course requires the boats to either tack or gybe. For races of 75% or greater, the BOUY rating will be used. If there is any doubt, the RLC Rating will be used. The PRO is solely responsible for determining which rating category is used and the decision cannot be appealed through redress. This amends RRS #60.1(b).

11. PRIZES:

11.1 - There will be awards in each class based on the number of entries (6.1) and an Overall 1st Place for Spinnaker(and Sportboats), Non-Spinnaker (and True Cruising) and Multihulls. **And there will be a trophy for Best Finishing MIYC Boat. The Hospice Trophies will be awarded by Hospice according to their NOR.**

11.2 – Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.

12. SAFETY:

12.1 - All boats are to carry a working VHF Radio capable of receiving and transmitting on marine Channels 16, 68, 72 and receiving VHF weather channels. The radio should be monitoring Channel 72 at all times unless otherwise directed by the RC Signal Boat.

13. DOCKAGE:

13.1 - Free dockage will be available at MIYC or The Marina at Factory Bay (Friday through Sunday night) for participating boats that require dockage (electricity available for \$5 per day). All boats can be accommodated, but priority will be based at the time of receipt of your Entry Form. **Ten minutes before your arrival in the marina, contact Dock Master Elmer Wheeler at 642-2531 or VHF Channel #16. . Rafting may be required so captains or other boat representatives must be at the dock by 9:00 AM each day. You must check in at the dockmaster's office after berthing your boat and have proof of liability insurance. The boat launch is on Rt. 951, 1/2 mile before the bridge to the Island.**

14. FURTHER INFORMATION:

14.1 - The first day's post race meeting will be at the MIYC Burgee Bar with complimentary beer, cash bar and cash food available. There will be a cash bar, complimentary beer, a sumptuous Buffet and Island style music by J. Robert at Sunday's awards ceremony. There will be a 50/50 Drawing at the Banquet Supporting Marco Island City Kids Youth Sailing (MICKYS) program and a Silent Auction. **The Hospice Trophies will also be awarded.**
